

COVID Safety Questions for Check-In

Updated April 8, 2021

1. Are you willing and able to attend the service with a **mask** on (over both nose and mouth) for the duration?
 - a. *No eating or drinking is allowed in the sanctuary in order to keep masks on at all times.*
2. Are you willing and able to maintain **social distancing** (at least 6 feet) for the duration?
3. Have you, or anyone in your household, had any **symptoms** of COVID-19 today or in the **past 14 days**?
 - a. *Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever of 100+, or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea.*
4. Have you or anyone in your household **traveled** to a COVID-19 hotspot or a state marked orange in Chicago's Travel Order in the **past 10 days**?
 - a. *Travel from these states is affected (as of April 8, 2021): Alaska, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, District of Columbia, Florida, Iowa, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Dakota, Tennessee, Vermont, Virginia, West Virginia*
 - b. *We will update our list of states weekly from Chicago's Emergency Travel Order website at: chicago.gov/city/en/sites/covid-19/home/emergency-travel-order.html*
 - c. *Those who are asymptomatic and fully vaccinated (2 weeks after final dose) are exempted from post-travel quarantine.*
5. Have you or anyone in your household been in **close contact**, today or in the **past 14 days**, with someone who has been **diagnosed with COVID-19**?
 - a. *Close contact means being within 6 feet of the infected individual for 15 minutes or more, cumulatively over a 24-hour period.*
 - b. *Those who are asymptomatic and fully vaccinated (2 weeks after final dose) are exempted from this rule.*
 - c. *Someone with COVID-19 may be contagious, or able to spread COVID-19, upto 3 days before the first symptom/first positive test through 10 days after the first symptom/first positive test.*
